



Create Your Vacancy


Once you have logged in, you will see this home page.



1. Click 'Manage Opportunities' to get started.



2. Click 'Create New Opportunity and Invite' to create your vacancy.



3. Fill out the details of your vacancy.



- In the role description, describe the school setting, the type of role and any skills you are looking for. You could also include the times and frequency of your meetings, and any other commitments.

Choose Volunteers

1. Click any coloured circles or pinpoints to zoom in and see individual volunteers



Each volunteer is indicated by a pinpoint:



Where there are a number of volunteers close together you will see circles with the number representing the number of volunteers. Click on the number to expand the point to individual volunteers:


2. Click on the pin to see their profile in brief.

4. Click 'Add to Shortlist' to put them in your shortlist of potential volunteers.


5. Click 'View Shortlist' above the map to review who you have selected.

You can search by governor skills.




You can also view volunteers in a list view by clicking on List underlined in blue.




Send Invitations
